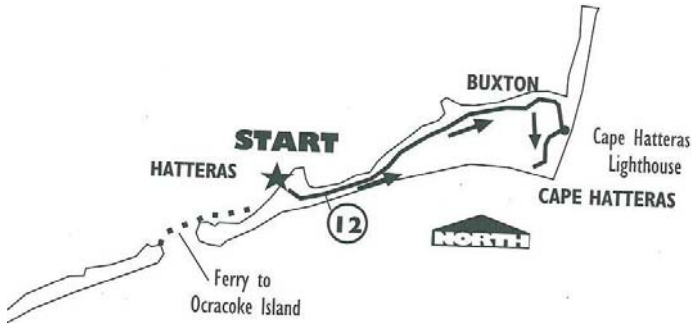

Getting There

Ride starts near southernmost end of Hatteras Island, which can be reached by free ferry from Ocracoke Island or by driving south from Nags Head along NC-12.

Miles	Turn	Directions
0.0	LEFT	Parking lot at ferry landing, onto NC-12
2.7	ENTER	Cape Hatteras National Seashore
4.2	ARRIVE	Regional beach access (rest rooms avail.)
4.6	PASS	Cape Hatteras pier
8.7	ENTER	Buxton
12.0	RIGHT	Cape Hatteras Lighthouse National Park
12.9	LEFT	Lighthouse parking lot; turn around retrace route
25.4	FINISH	At ferry landing
